

Town of Fenwick Island 2013 Summer Information Guide



Welcome! We hope you enjoy your stay. We hope this pamphlet will be of help to you. For your enjoyment and protection, various laws and ordinances are in effect here and are strictly enforced.

NOISE: The Town takes pride in being one of the "Quiet Resorts". It is unlawful to make a noise disturbance which annoys or disturbs a reasonable person of normal sensitivities or to allow another person to make such noise disturbance, within the Town or on the ocean beach. Therefore, please be considerate of others, especially before 8:00 am or after 8:00 p.m.

The discharge of fireworks is unsafe and a **violation** of State law and the Town noise ordinance.

TOBACCO-FREE BEACH AND PARKS

By Ordinance it is unlawful to burn a cigarette, cigar, pipe or other matter or substance that contains tobacco on all Fenwick Island beaches and parks. Fine \$100 for each instance.



BEACH: The lifeguards will do their best to protect you; however, swimming in the ocean is **always** an inherently dangerous activity and you do so at your own risk. Please obey the directions of the lifeguards when they determine that swimming may be dangerous due to ocean and/or weather conditions.

- ◆ Dogs/domestic animals on the beach
PROHIBITED: May 1-Sept. 30
- ◆ Alcoholic beverages on the beach
(Possession or consumption)
PROHIBITED: May 15 - Sept. 15
- ◆ Glass containers on the beach
PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES
- ◆ Fishing, launching or beaching of non-motorized vehicles from the beach
PROHIBITED WHILE LIFEGUARD ON DUTY, EXCEPT AS PERMITTED BY LIFEGUARD CAPTAIN
- ◆ Juvenile Curfew Midnight — 6:00 AM
MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY PARENT (OR DESIGNEE) OR EN ROUTE TO/FROM WORK

Our **Dunes** are very important to the safety of property. Disturbance of the fences or vegetation causes erosion and is **a violation of State Law**. Please stay off the dunes and do not allow your children to play there.

BONFIRES on the beach are allowed within Town limits for **PROPERTY OWNERS** or **Leased Rentals** with a special permit. Inquiries about bonfire permits may be made at the Public Safety Building Monday through Friday during regular business hours. Some restrictions apply. \$50 Fee \$100 Deposit

PARKING: Visitor parking permits are required from **May 15 thru September 15** to park on any street between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. These permits are available for purchase at the Public Safety Building 7 days a week 9:00AM-3:00PM. Handicapped Parking available with the purchase of a Town Parking Pass

Daily permits

\$10.00 per day Monday -Thursday
\$20.00 per day Friday - Sunday and Holidays

Weekender permits

\$50.00 (3 consecutive days)

Weekly permits

\$60.00 (7 consecutive days)

Monthly permits

\$200.00 (30 consecutive days)

Summer permits

\$400.00 May 15-Sept 15

HANG TAGS MUST BE VISIBLE

Do not park closer than 15 feet from any intersection or fire hydrant and do not block any private driveway area. Vehicles must be parked parallel to and *off the paved street* and in the same direction as the traffic flow.

Permits are hung on the rear view mirror, with year and date facing out. The resident stick-on permits must be placed directly on the rear bumper on the driver's side.



The **"beach-ends"** or diagonal spaces are reserved for Fenwick Island property owners with blue permit only.




LITTER: It is unlawful to throw, place, deposit, allow or maintain any trash, garbage or other such substance upon any street, beach, public way or private property within the Town. Residential trash collection is made on **Mondays and Thursdays** during the summer season.

ANIMAL CONTROL: It is unlawful for an owner to allow his or her animal to go upon any property, public or private, within the Town except on property owned or leased by the owner of the animal. Animal(s) are **not permitted** to run loose; they must be on a leash. Defecation in walkways, streets, beach entrances or other area used by the public is prohibited. Please be considerate of others and remove any feces immediately and dispose of it in a sanitary manner.

FEEDING BIRDS AND WATERFOWL: Feeding of birds or ducks is **not** allowed. It is unlawful for anyone to cause or permit to be fed, or provide food for domestic or migratory birds or waterfowl on land or in the water, either privately or publicly owned. Please be considerate of those enjoying the area around you.
