Whether you are a visiting vacationer or full time resident, we want the time you spend here to be picture perfect. We have introduced a no-smoking ordinance that applies to all of our beaches and town parks.

If you do smoke, please properly dispose of your tobacco product in the cigarette receptacles that are provided at the dune crossings. Please do not throw cigarette butts on the ground or in the dunes. Thank you in advance for complying with the ordinance. No Smoking on Fenwick Beaches and in Town Parks



facts

Cigarettes contain over **4,000 chemicals** and additives.

During the fall DNREC Coastal Clean-ups of 2011 and 2012, Fenwick Island volunteers picked up **699 cigarette butts** and **125 cigar tips**.

When a cigarette is thrown onto the ground it can end up in our **waterways and the ocean**. Fish and other animals mistake these items for food.

It takes an average of **25 years** for a cigarette to decompose. While this process is happening, some of those 4,000 **chemicals leach into the ground**. This pollutes the water, soil and plant life.
