C. Signage Required:
 No person shall be prosecuted for violation of this section unless signs, readily visible to the public, are posted in appropriate areas at or near the entrance(s) to those areas where smoking is prohibited.
D. Enforcement:
 A first violation of this section will result in a written warning. Subsequent violations shall result in the imposition of fines and penalties in accordance with §116-7 of this Chapter.
