## Public Works Department

### February 2020 Report

- **Gravel and Drainage**
  - Dug gravel to form a channel on Winward Way to direct standing water to canal
- **Inventory**
  - Started Public Works equipment inventory (about 75% complete)
- **Landscaping**
  - Continued removing overgrown shrubs, grasses and tree branches from beach parking areas
  - Continued removing tree branches blocking signs along Bunting Ave. and side streets
- **Vehicle Lighting**
  - Removed all police lighting, sirens, wiring and control boxes from Ford Taurus
  - Installed lights on lifeguards Polaris 4x4
- **Police Vehicles**
  - Installed rifle holders in two police vehicles
- **Lifeguard Stands**
  - Built one new lifeguard stand to replace older, non-repairable stand
  - Repaired several stands and started painting stands
  - Finished painting lifeguard stands
- **Routine Maintenance**
  - Weekly check on dog bag stations
  - Daily inspection of dune fencing ropes & repair, if needed
  - Continued cleaning and organizing Public Works building
  - Dune crossing checks
