Farmington Street Improvements

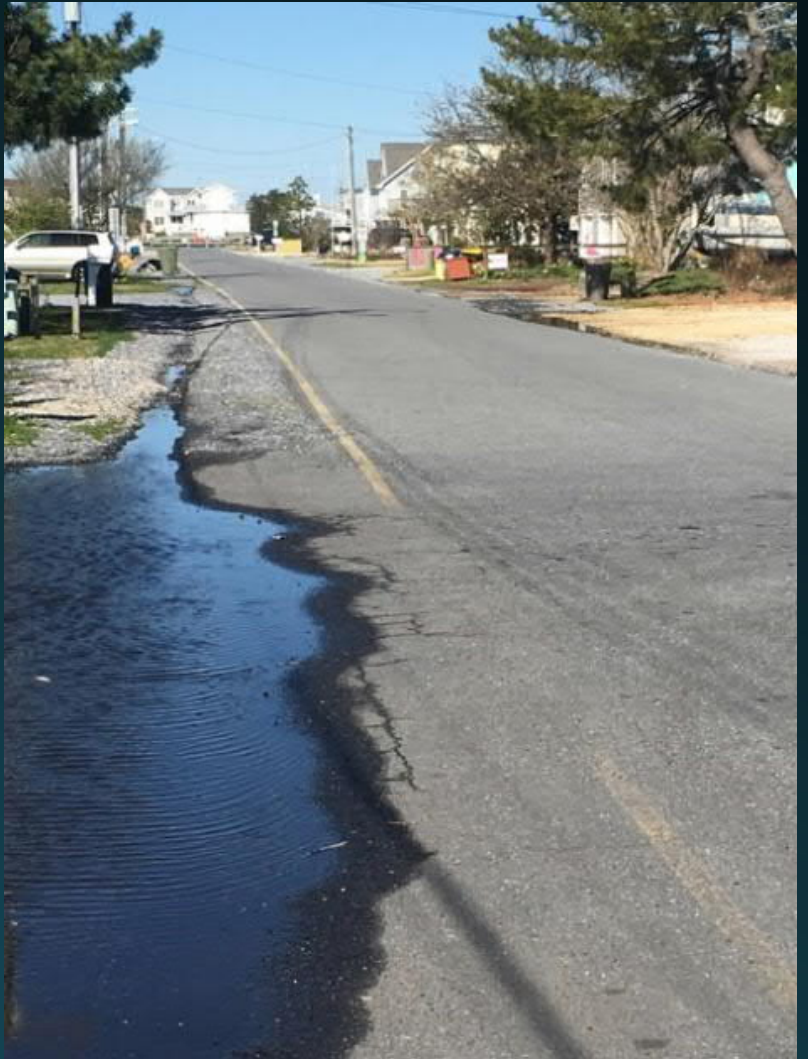


Project Description

- Water is ponding after rain events leaving large puddles along Farmington Street.
- Looking for a solution considering a limited budget and desire to limit disruption of residents/businesses.
- A similar project was constructed previously within Fenwick (West Dagsboro Street)

Existing Condition after rainfall.

Water is sitting and ponding after rainfall events. Notably fronting residences along street. More significant ponding at Our Harvest Restaurant and Fenwick Eclectic.





Existing Conditions Plan

Improved Condition after rainfall (W. Dagsboro St.).

Dry shoulders, no ponding after same rainfall
event Sunday March 28, 2021.









Explanation of Project

- Perforated pipe to be installed in gravel trenches providing storage and improved water quality along Farmington.
- Installing additional catch basins to convey storms.
- Connecting new pipe system to existing outfalls in canals.
- Temporary erosion control devices will be installed prior to construction and will remain until completion.

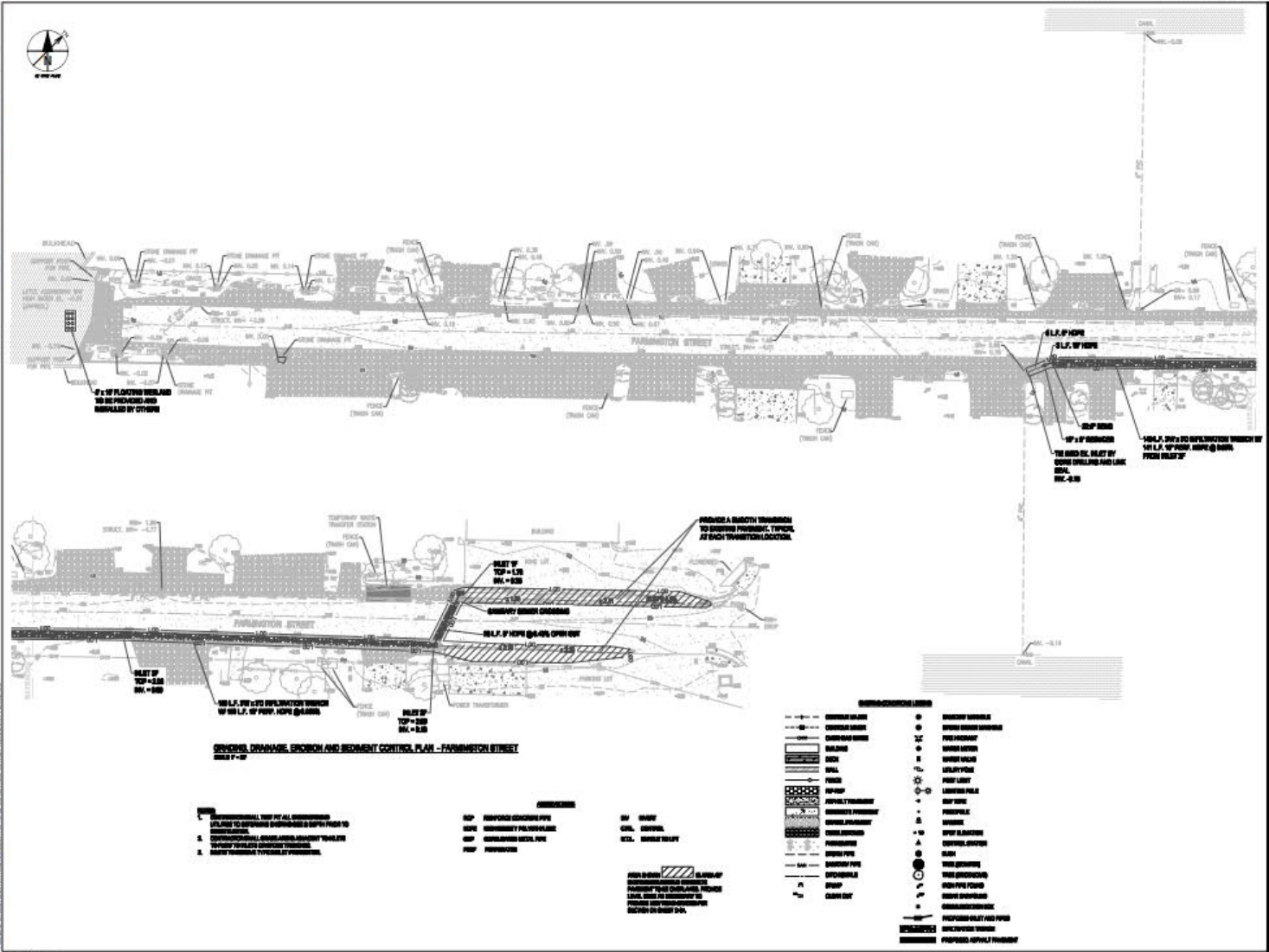
