

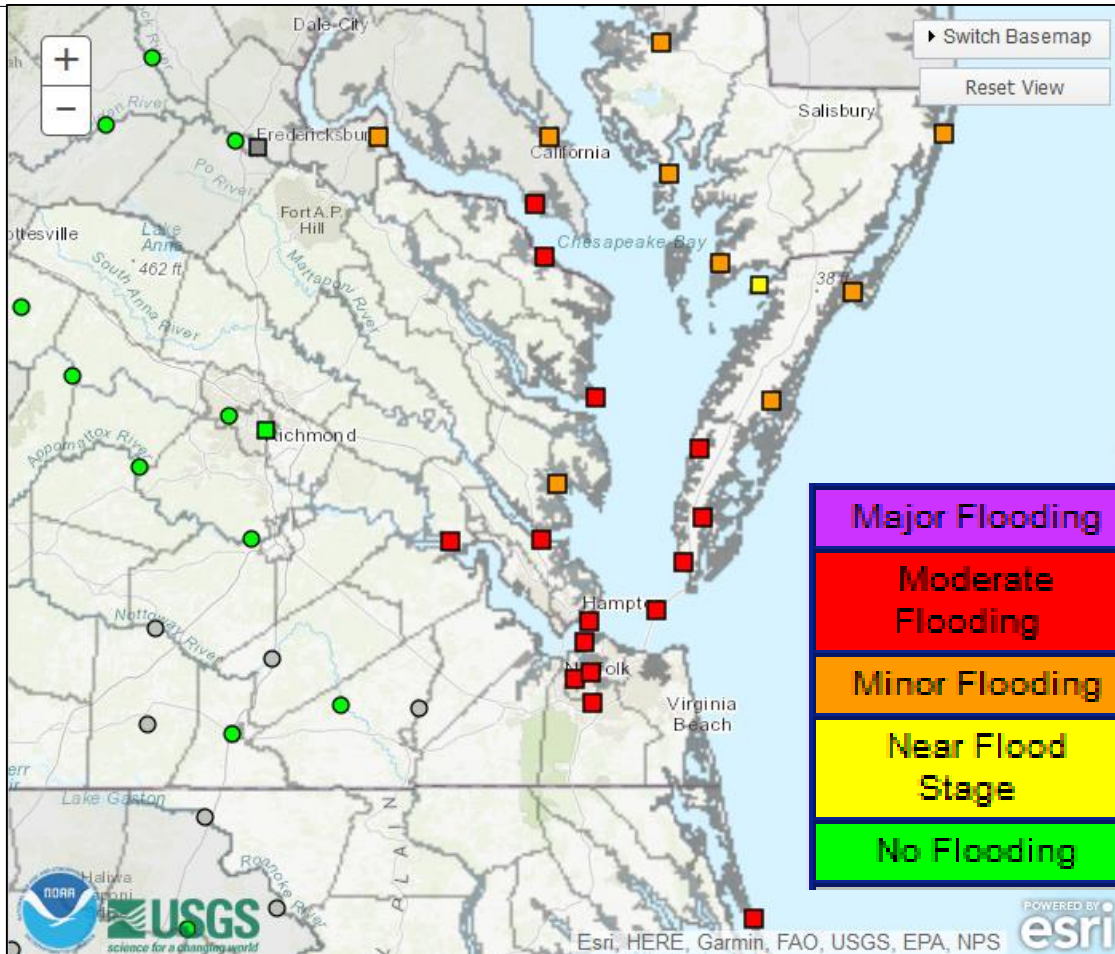
Minor to Moderate Tidal Flooding Today

OVERVIEW

- A combination of King Tides, high pressure northeast of the area, and low pressure off the coast will result in **widespread minor to moderate tidal flooding today.**



TIMING

- Minor to moderate tidal flooding is expected during **high tide later this morning into the afternoon.**
- Additional **minor to locally moderate tidal flooding** is possible during high tide **later Monday morning into the afternoon.**

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Moderate tidal flooding is expected from the western shore of the Chesapeake Bay through Hampton Roads, the lower Eastern Shore, and the Currituck Outer Banks. Minor flooding is expected elsewhere.
- Widespread flooding** of vulnerable areas will result in an **elevated threat of property damage** where moderate flooding is forecast.
