BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The recommendation for rubber speed bumps was approved by the Infrastructure Committee and endorsed by Chief Devlin and Mike Locke. They would be rubber speed bumps with plastic end caps and reflective to enhance visibility at night.

1 set would be placed on Maryland Avenue and 1 set would be placed Island Avenue to slow traffic before the stop signs. Public Works would remove for the winter season due to potential snow removal and replace prior to Spring.

6' Speed Bump= \$139.95*4= \$559.80

End Cap= \$24.95*4= \$99.80
