# TOWN MANAGER'S UPDATE Monthly Activity Update for June 2024

June 2024 was an active and productive month for the Town Manager and staff. Efforts to strengthen community ties began with visits to local businesses alongside Chief Morrissey. Several committee meetings were attended, covering residential concerns, business, beach, dredging, emergency management, infrastructure, and pedestrian safety.

Key collaborations included discussions with a representative of Congresswoman Lisa Blunt Rochester about potential federal funding and a meet and greet with Phil Brackin of the Bethany Beach Volunteer Fire Department. The manager also participated in a FEMA Disaster Preparedness webinar and supported DelDOT's grant application for sidewalk project funding.

Engagement with town staff continued with a meet and greet for Capt. Ryk and the lifeguards. Public works initiatives saw progress with ongoing median maintenance and the addition of new parking spaces at Town Hall. Resident concerns about beach access were addressed, and election-related activities included certifying Council candidates and swearing in Board of Elections members.

June also involved budget and planning committee meetings and emergency response discussions with OCMD CERT. The manager met with Comcast regarding the town's franchise agreement and kicked off the Straughn Resiliency Project with key stakeholders. Discussions on the Cyber Grant status and contract renewal were held with Wagamon's.

As the summer season is now in full swing, staff are busy preparing for the elections that will be held on August 3 from 1-5 p.m. at Town Hall. The town bonfire event on July 6 was a huge success, thanks to our generous business sponsors! Reassessment letters were sent out on July 17, with appeals scheduled for July 24. Tax letters will be mailed out on August 1.

 Began visiting town businesses with Chief Morrissey to introduce ourselves and share our contact information with them.

- Held a meeting with DNREC to explore funding for a water bottle refill station in the park, with the town covering initial costs and seeking reimbursement.

Attended a FEMA Region 3 Disaster Preparedness webinar.

#### **Sidewalk Project Support:**

• Submitted a letter of support to Secretary Buttigieg for DelDOT's application for the Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program Grant to assist with our sidewalk project.

#### Staff Engagement:

• Held a meet and greet with Capt. Ryk and the lifeguards.

#### **Public Works and Infrastructure:**

- The Public Works team continued to water and monitor the medians.
- Mike Locke oversaw the repaving of the Town Hall parking lot, adding two additional parking spaces to alleviate staff parking issues.

#### **Resident Concerns:**

Met with a resident to address concerns about beach access over the dunes.

#### **Election Activities:**

- Attended the Board of Elections meeting where Council candidates were certified.
- Participated in a Special Town Council meeting to swear in the Board of Elections members.

## **Budget and Planning:**

- Attended the Budget and Finance Committee meeting.
- Participated in the Planning Commission meeting.

#### **Emergency Response Planning:**
