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TOWN MANAGER'S RECAP Monthly Activity Update for August 2024

As summer winds down, the Town Manager and staff remained busy throughout August, focusing on the smooth execution of the election on August 3. Thanks to the dedicated efforts of the Board of Elections and staff, the event went off without any issues. Tax letters were mailed out on August 1, and we have started receiving payments.

Throughout the month, the Town Manager participated in various committee meetings, including Residential Concerns, Business, Infrastructure, Pedestrian Safety, Environmental, and Planning. The Council reorganization meeting and swearing-in ceremony were also significant events.

The Town Manager worked closely with the Mayor and Town Solicitor on a potential resolution to an easement dispute and responded to several FOIA requests, including those for absentee ballot information, property records, and utility shut-off notices. A resident's complaint about food spoilage due to a power outage was addressed, and staff investigated and resolved a water leak behind Town Hall.

Additional activities included working with property owners to address concerns about an unsightly garden and weeds, conducting a CO house visit, and collaborating with Mike Locke on a bulkhead issue. Staff also worked with the County election office on logistics for the upcoming September 10 Primary election. The Town Manager, along with Chief Morrissey and Mayor Magdeburger, toured the OCMD Emergency Management facilities.

Looking ahead, staff are beginning to establish their goals for the fall. One major focus will be working with the IT Committee and Council to organize existing data, both electronic and paper, to streamline staff work and improve efficiency.

This month has set a strong foundation for the busy fall season ahead, ensuring the town's operations continue to run smoothly as we transition into the next phase of the year.

FOIA Requests:

- Responded to a FOIA request for absentee ballot information.
- Responded to 3 additional FOIA requests related to property records, utility shut-off notices.

Resident and Property Concerns:

- Working to resolve a resident's complaint regarding a power outage and the resulting food spoilage.
- Worked with property owners regarding concerns about the condition of an old garden/flower bed that is unsightly due to weeds and overgrowth.
- Proposed a resolution to a parking lot safety concern raised by residents.
- Went on a CO house visit with Mike Locke.
- Worked alongside Mike Locke on a bulkhead concern that was submitted in mid-June.

Town Operations and Infrastructure:

- Worked with staff to investigate and stop a water leak under the pavement located behind the Town Hall.
- Toured the OCMD Emergency Management facilities with Chief and Natalie.
- Worked with the Mayor and Town Solicitor on a potential resolution to an easement dispute.

Special Events:
