RECOMMENDED ACTION: Add parking regulations to Chapter 112 of the Town of Fenwick Island Code	

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The Town of Fenwick Island has no regulation governing the movement of parked vehicles. Vehicles with a parking permit can currently park in a legal revenue spot and not move for weeks or months. Inoperable vehicles can be parked on town streets with a parking permit. The FIPD is proposing a 72 -consecutive-hour limit for on-street parking in one spot. Vehicles not moved can be ticketed and towed.

ABANDONED VEHICLES

Vehicles that are parked on a town street in the same spot for more than seven days may be considered abandoned and are subject to ticketing and/or towing- even if you have a valid residential parking permit. If a vehicle is deemed to be abandoned and presents any type of safety issue, the town may tow that vehicle immediately.
